

"Rear Window" is a film of exceptional quality. The film stars James Stewart and it is not simply about a crime or detective story. Stewart is a handicapped, he can't walk, so he moves on his wheelchair. He works as a photojournalist and lives in a village in Greenwich. His apartment overlooks a courtyard where he saw something too serious. On one of those long winter nights he witnessed a murder in the courtyard. Being disabled he couldn't help the victim, but he phoned the police who arrived too late. The star begins to blame himself because he couldn't do much to save the murdered. So, a fixed idea starts to occupy his mind that he himself has taken part in the murder. Actually, he's done nothing, but even the viewer develops the same feeling like the star's. And here comes much of the film's power; we feel Stewart's sympathy to the murder. There is also the delightful character of Thelma Ritter. She is an insurance company nurse who takes care of Stewart and even makes him sandwiches. She is very kind and humane at a time when modern health care has got too bad. The intelligent and splendid performance of both stars makes the film quite fascinating. There is also the exceptional manner in which the music and sound effects are mixed. But most important, it is the director's witty and clever handling of the story, in addition to the brilliant and beautiful camerawork.
