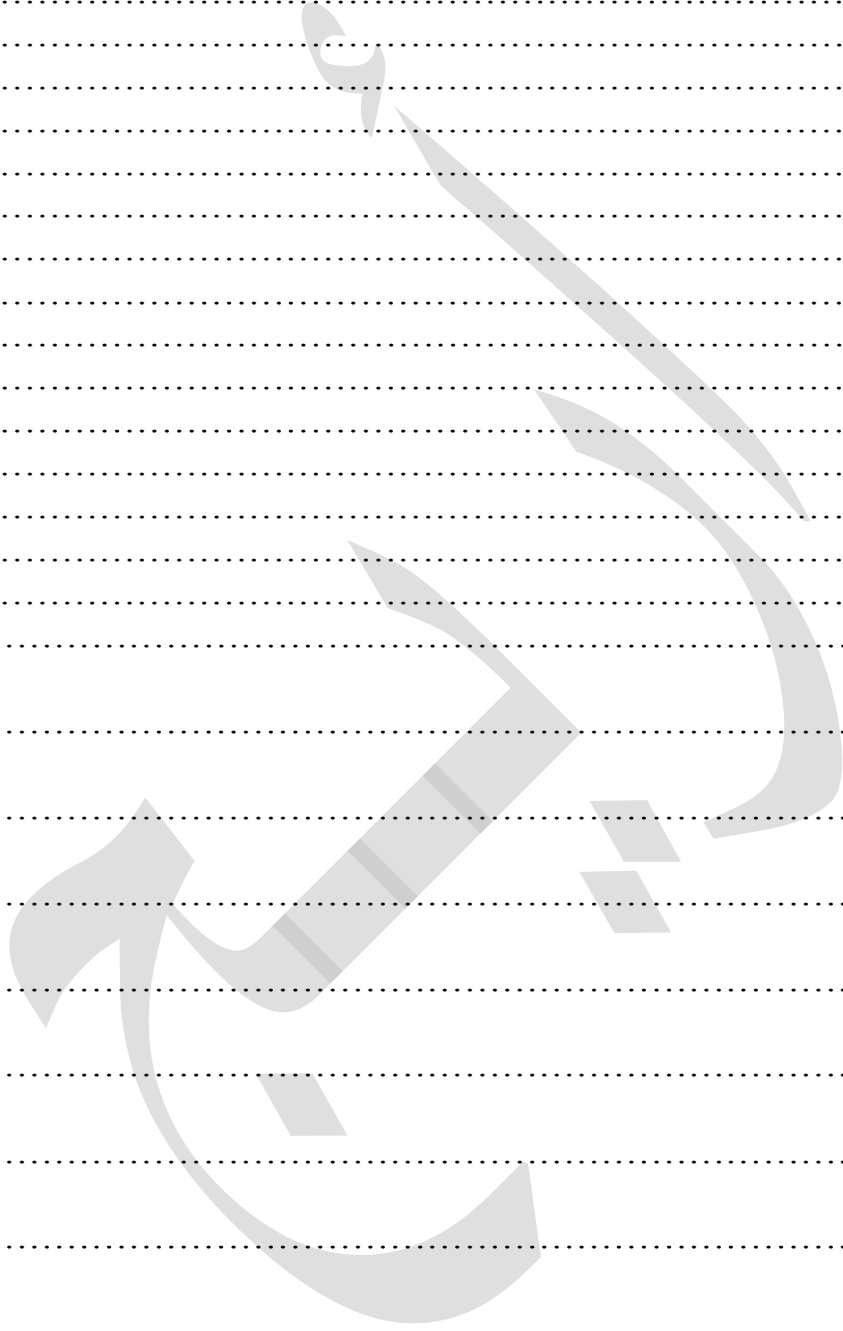

At that time there were laws segregating black and white people. Segregating means keeping **them** apart. Rosa Parks went to a school with all African American students. Whites and blacks were forced to go to different schools. After she got her high school diploma, she helped her family earn money by working as a seamstress in a department store. Rosa Parks became **renowned** when she was sitting in a bus and refused to give up her seat to a white man. There was a law in Alabama that said black people had to leave their seat on a bus if a white person wanted to sit down. She believed she had dignity and whites were not better than her because she was black. Rosa Parks was arrested for not giving up her seat .She still felt she did the right thing. After that, All African Americans boycotted the bus for over a year. They also held many peaceful protests conducted by Martin Luther King, Jr. to whom that segregation was illegal. Now whites and blacks could go to the same schools. They did not have to give up their seats on buses .Considered a heroine today because she believed everyone should be treated equally. She was honored in 1996 by president Bill Clinton, who gave her the presidential medal of freedom , the highest honor a citizen can receive .

The discovery that the seeds of some plants can be eaten had an important effect on man's development. It made him realize that he could stay in one place and grow some of his own food. The grains of the wheat plant form the basic ingredient of bread. The other ingredients of bread are yeast, sugar, water, salt and fat. In Europe bread is usually made in many stages. The first stage is to make what is called "dough". The yeast is mixed with sugar and water then added to flour, salt and fat. All these ingredients are then pressed with the hands for about ten minutes until they form a large ball of dough. After the dough has been made in this way, it is left to "rise". This second stage of rising takes about two hours. At the third stage that rising dough is pressed again and pushed into the shape the bread is to be. It is then ready for the final stage of baking, which takes about forty five minutes in a hot oven.
