Instead of going to school to gain a good education, children in underdeveloped countries set out to work from as young as four or five years old. By the age of twelve, most of them are given the responsibilities of looking after and supporting their parents who are often weak from hunger and ill health.

Deprived of any form of education from such a young age, these underprivileged children are forced to take up illegal odd jobs which often have hazardous and unsuitable working conditions. Since it is illegal for young children to work, the corporations or factories that do hire these children hide them away from the main working areas. They trap children for long stretches of time in dark and dirty rooms. In India, for example, there are children who work in factories which manufacture matches. The working hours in these factories are long and the work is hard, but what is most significant is that such factories are potential fire hazards. Not only do these children risk their lives by working, but they are also paid little money.

The United Nations encouraged countries to prohibit importing products made by children under the age of 15. We may think such measures will stop the problem of child **exploitation**, but the truth is they may lead to other problems. Even though the factories may be exploiting children by paying them low salaries, they do nevertheless provide them with a more or less safe working environment and proper jobs. Dismissing children from work does not necessarily mean that children will no longer work. In fact, they may end up in the hands of drug pushers or other criminals and spend their life selling drugs or stealing for a living.

<u>VI- Reading Comprehension and Summary Making (160 Marks)</u> <u>Read the following passage carefully, then answer the questions below:</u>

Every time you take a breath, you are inhaling Earth's atmosphere. You cannot see, smell, or taste Earth's atmosphere. It is the air all around you. Other planets also have an atmosphere. An atmosphere is a blanket of gases that wraps around a planet or any other object in space.

Earth's atmosphere is made up of a mix of gases called air. Air contains more nitrogen than any other gas. Nitrogen makes up 78 percent of the air. Oxygen, the gas that is most important for keeping you alive, makes up 21 percent. Earth is the only planet to have so much oxygen in <u>its</u> atmosphere. Water vapour and other gases are also present in small amounts in Earth's atmosphere. The pull of gravity holds the atmosphere in place. Gravity is the force that also keeps you from floating away from Earth.

Although air has weight, you cannot feel it. All the air in the atmosphere presses downward. This weight is called atmospheric pressure which depends on how much gas is in the atmosphere. The higher you go, the less air there is and the lower the atmospheric pressure gets. The atmosphere is heaviest and the atmospheric pressure highest close to Earth. Differences in air temperature close to Earth form areas of high and low pressure. Warm air is light and rises upwards. It makes low-pressure areas. Cold air is heavy and sinks. It makes high-pressure areas.



For centuries, the tallest buildings were made of stone. The base, or lower walls, of a tall building had to be very <u>thick</u> in order to support the upper walls. The taller the building was, the thicker the lower walls had to be. In this sense, it was difficult to make real skyscrapers possible.

It took two important technological advancements to make real skyscrapers possible. The first advancement was the mass production of iron and steel. The second was the production of lightweight metal beams. In 1880s, architects started using these beams to support the walls of buildings.

Using metal beams has a lot of advantages. These buildings with metal beams didn't need thick walls at the base, so they could be much taller. Besides, the building walls were thinner, and they could have more windows, which made the rooms much more pleasant. In addition, they wanted to make the buildings as beautiful as possible. Over the years, many problems connected to high-rise buildings were solved, and buildings got taller and taller.







Isaac Newton was always wondering about the things he saw around him. What holds the Moon and planets in the sky? How does a rainbow form? He uncovered basic laws of nature. He used mathematics to explain these laws and predict how objects would behave. He became one of the greatest scientists of all time .

Newton was born in Wools Thorpe, England, on December 25, 1642. He loved to build mechanical models, but he was not a good student. His mother took him out of school so that he could help run the family farm. Newton did not like farming. He liked to read and study on his own. A previous teacher knew that Newton was very smart and helped him go to the University of Cambridge. After Newton graduated, **plague** broke out in Cambridge. Many people got sick and died. Newton went back to the family farm for two years until the plague ended. He came up with many of his greatest ideas from 1665 to 1667 while he was alone in the countryside.

Newton went back to Cambridge and became a professor of mathematics. He built the first reflecting telescope, **which** uses a mirror instead of a lens. Newton invented a new kind of mathematics called calculus. Today, scientists and engineers use calculus to solve many kinds of problems. Newton came up with theories about gravity and motion. He thought that the same force pulling people and apples down to Earth keeps the Moon going around Earth and the planets going around the Sun. He used mathematics to prove his theories. Newton used a prism, a piece of glass with many sides, to study light. He found that sunlight is made up of every colour in the rainbow. He became **famous** for his calculus, but he did not tell many people about his theory of gravity. He was shy and modest and did not want other scientists to criticise his work. Finally his friends had him write a book about gravity and motion titled Principia Mathematica. Scientists called the book a masterpiece. Newton was honoured. When he died on March 20, 1727, he became the first scientist to be buried in Westminster Abbey in London.

He used mathematics to explain these laws and predict how objects would behave. He became one of the greatest scientists of all time.

Newton was born in Wools Thorpe, England, on December 25, 1642. He loved to build mechanical models, but he was not a good student. His mother took him out of school so that he could help run the family farm. Newton did not like farming. He liked to read and study on his own. A previous teacher knew that Newton was very smart and helped him go to the University of Cambridge. After Newton graduated, **plague** broke out in Cambridge. Many people got sick and died. Newton went back to the family farm for two years until the plague ended. He came up with many of his greatest ideas from 1665 to 1667 while he was alone in the countryside.

Newton went back to Cambridge and became a professor of mathematics. He built the first reflecting telescope, **which** uses a mirror instead of a lens. Newton invented a new kind of mathematics called calculus. Today, scientists and engineers use calculus to solve many kinds of problems. Newton came up with theories about gravity and motion. He thought that the same force pulling people and apples down to Earth keeps the Moon going around Earth and the planets going around the Sun. He used mathematics to prove his theories. Newton used a prism, a piece of glass with many sides, to study light. He found that sunlight is made up of every colour in the rainbow. He became **famous** for his calculus, but he did not tell many people about his theory of gravity. He was shy and modest and did not want other scientists to criticise his work. Finally his friends had him write a book about gravity and motion titled Principia Mathematica. Scientists called the book a masterpiece. Newton was honoured. When he died on March 20, 1727, he became the first scientist to be buried in Westminster Abbey in London.


