The number of people moving into volcanic hazardous areas is increasing in post-industrial as well as developing countries. Southern Italy is an example. Mt. Vesuvius is located right on the edge of Naples. It has a 2000-year history of eruptions. Yet, there are 3.75 million people living within 30 kilometers of the mountain.

One of the world's most famous volcanoes is Mt. Etna in Sicily. Sicily is an island in the Mediterranean Sea with more than 5 million inhabitants.
