

Nowadays, the three top winners get gold, silver and bronze medals at the end of each event.

The Olympics are held every four years in different countries all over the world. There are now four different types of Olympics games that suit different people: The Summer Games which originally started in Greece; The Winter Games which focus on snow and ice games; The Paralympics which allow disabled athletes to join; and The Youth Games which give athletes between the ages of 14 and 18 a chance to compete.


